Renowned for relief printmaking and innovative, accessible instruction, Iron Frog Press bridges traditional techniques with community engagement. The studio is particularly recognized for hands-on workshops, artist-centered teaching, and the invention of the Original Glass Baren™, a hand-printing tool that makes printmaking approachable for artists of all levels.

Iron Frog Press collaborates with cultural institutions, libraries, museums, schools, and community groups to deliver meaningful, inclusive art experiences that inspire creativity and connection.

Matt Bagley, founder and master printmaker at Iron Frog Press, brings over 30 years of printmaking experience to his teaching and workshops. He is passionate about helping artists of all levels—from beginners to advanced—develop their skills and discover their creative voice. Matt emphasizes technique and building confidence, ensuring that every participant leaves inspired and empowered.
